#### ORDER

1. Ld. Counsel for the parties present.

### 2. IA(IBC)/693(KB)2021

- (a) This is an application filed by Mr. Pankaj Kumar Tibrewal, Resolution Professional, praying for extension of the CIRP period beyond 180 days, which has expired on 03/08/2021, by a further period of 90 days.
- (b) The brief facts of the case are that CIRP was commenced vide order dated 07/08/2019 appointing Mr. Shashi Agarwal as the Interim Resolution Professional. Subsequently, his appointment as a Resolution Professional was confirmed by the CoC. The CoC at its 5<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 05/12/2019 had passed a resolution to initiate liquidation process. This

Adjudicating Authority *vide* order dated 07/02/2020 has passed an order initiating liquidation process against the Corporate Debtor appointing Mr. Shashi Agarwal as the Liquidator.

- (c) Being aggrieved by the aforesaid order dated 07/02/2020, applicant (Operational Creditor) moved before the Hon'ble NCLAT challenging the Order of Liquidation dated 07/02/2020. The Hon'ble NCLAT vide order dated 04/06/2021 passed in Company Appeal (AT) (Insolvency) No. 348(KB) of 2020 (Jayanta Banerjee -vs- Shashi Agarwal & Anr.) has quashed and set aside the liquidation process and directed the NCLT, Kolkata Bench to appoint a new IRP replacing the present Liquidator.
- (d) Thereafter, vide order dated 16/06/2021, this Adjudicating Authority has appointed the present applicant, Mr. Pankaj Kumar Tibrewal, as IRP for re-initiating the CIRP.
- (e) The CoC at its 6<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 16/07/2021 has passed resolutions by 93.03% voting share approving extension of the CIRP period by 90 days beyond 03/08/2021 and also appointed the Interim Resolution Professional as the Resolution Professional.
- (f) We have perused the application and the documents attached therewith and heard the Ld. Counsel for the Resolution Professional. We are satisfied that the prayer made in the IA should be allowed. Therefore, extension of the CIRP period by a further period of 90 days, beyond 03/08/2021, is allowed.
- (g) IA(IBC)/693(KB)2021 shall stand disposed of accordingly.
- (h) List the main CP on **08/11/2021** for filing further progress.
- 3. Rest of the IAs shall be tagged along on that date.

## 2. IA(IBC)/241(KB)2022 & IA(IBC)274(KB)2022

- (a) These two IAs are taken together for convenience.
- (b) RP has moved these two IAs seeking extension of time of CIRP period by 15 days and 45 days respectively, thereby seeking extension of 60 days in total beyond 270 days, which has ended on 13/03/2022.
