“NCLT” shall mean the National Company Law Tribunal, New Delhi Bench.

“Person” shall mean an individual, a partnership firm, an association, a corporation, a limited company, a trust, a body corporate, bank or financial institution or any other body, whether incorporated or not.

“Public Advertisement” shall mean an announcement **dated 11/06/2024** in newspaper(s) inviting an expression of interest from the Bidders, who shall submit their Bid to participate in the liquidation process of the Company in accordance with the provisions of IBC and Liquidation Process Regulations.

“Qualified Bidder(s)” shall mean a Bidder who fulfills the eligibility criteria listed out in the E-Auction Process Information Document.

“Representatives” shall include partners, directors, officers, employees, affiliates, agents, consultants, advisors or such other representatives of the relevant Person expressly authorized by such Person pursuant to corporate authorizations, powers of attorney, or contract.

“**Site Visit**” shall mean a visit to the Site; and

“**Successful Bidder**” means, the Qualified Bidder whose Bid is approved and who is declared successful by the Liquidator in consultation with SCC members at the end of the determined auction phase as per the provision of this E-Auction Process Information Document, provisions of IBC and the Liquidation Process Regulations and shall include the SPV (if any) through which the Successful Bidder proposes to consummate the sale transaction as per this E-Auction Process Document.

C. INTRODUCTION:

1. The Company’s Liquidation Process has been initiated under the provisions of the IBC and the Liquidation Process Regulations by an order of the NCLT with effect from 31st October, 2019. (A copy of same was received by the liquidator on 24th December, 2019). As per the said order, Mrs. Deepika Bhugra Prasad has been appointed as the Liquidator.
2. It is the endeavor of the Liquidator to sell the assets and properties comprising the liquidation estate of the Company in the manner specified under Regulation 32 of the Liquidation Process Regulations, any other rules, regulations, orders, circulars, directions or notifications or the like, issued pursuant to or under the IBC or the Liquidation Process Regulations, as the case may be, and as per directions, if any, of the NCLT in respect of the liquidation process of the Company and in the manner specified in this E-Auction Process Information Document.
3. The E-Auction would be conducted in the manner specified in the Schedule I, as provided under Regulation 33 of the Liquidation Process Regulations, any

other rules, regulations, orders, circulars, directions or notifications or the like, issued pursuant to or under the IBC or the Liquidation Process Regulations, as the case may be, and as per directions, if any, of the NCLT in respect of the liquidation process of the Company and in the manner specified in this E-Auction Process Information Document.

4. The E-Auction Participants are encouraged to make themselves acquainted with the provisions of the IBC and the Liquidation Process Regulations and any other rules, regulations, orders, circulars, directions or notifications or the like issued pursuant to or under the IBC or the Liquidation Process Regulations, as the case may be.

D. THE COMPANY AND IT'S ASSETS OVERVIEW:

Brief Background:

Compact Lamps Pvt. Ltd. (herein referred as "Corporate Debtor") is a Company limited by shares incorporated on 26/08/2005 under Companies Act, 1956. It is classified as an Indian Non - Government Company and is registered with RoC-Delhi at the registered address at No. 101/F village Gharonda Neem Ka Bangar Main Road Village Patparganj, Near Mayur Vihar Phase-1, Delhi, East Delhi 110091.

Present Status:

On 11th January 2019, the National Company Law Tribunal, Delhi Bench, initiated the Corporate Insolvency Resolution Process for the Company. However, as there was no Resolution approved by the CoC, the NCLT, Delhi Bench ordered for liquidation of the Company on 31st October, 2019 (A copy of same was received by the liquidator on 24th December, 2019). Ms. Deepika Bhugra Prasad, an Insolvency Professionals, holding IBBI Registration Number: IBBI/IPA-003/IP-N000110/2017-2018/11186 was appointed as the Liquidator of the Company. The Liquidator has the custody and control of the assets of the manufacturing Units of the company and the Liquidator has appointed a security agency to secure the premises. There is no production that is taking place at the any of the units and they are in shut down condition.

E. ELIGIBILITY:

An E-Auction Process Applicant shall not be eligible to submit a bid for purchase of

assets of the Company if it fails to meet the eligibility criteria as set out in Section 29A of the IBC (as amended from time to time).

LEGAL CRITERIA:

An E-Auction Process Applicant shall not be eligible to submit a bid for purchase of assets of the Company if it fails to meet the eligibility criteria as set out in Section 29A of the IBC (as amended from time to time). A careful reading of Section 29-A of the IBC states that a person shall not be eligible to submit a bid, if such person, or any other person acting jointly or in concert with such person –

- a) Is an undischarged insolvent;
- b) Is a willful defaulter in accordance with the guidelines of the Reserve Bank of India issued under the Banking Regulation Act, 1949;
- c) At the time of submission of the resolution plan has an account, or an account of a corporate debtor under the management or control of such person or of whom such person is a promoter, classified as non-performing asset in accordance with the guidelines of the Reserve Bank of India issued under the Banking Regulation Act, 1949 (10 of 1949) [or the guidelines of a financial sector regulator issued under any other law for the time being in force,] and at least a period of one year has lapsed from the date of such classification till the date of commencement of the corporate insolvency resolution process of the Corporate Debtor.

Provided that the person shall be eligible to submit a resolution plan if such person makes payment of all overdue amounts with interest thereon and charges relating to nonperforming asset accounts before submission of resolution plan: I Provided further that nothing in this clause shall apply to a resolution applicant where such applicant is a financial entity and is not a related party to the corporate debtor.

Explanation I. - For the purposes of this proviso, the expression "related party" shall not include a financial entity, regulated by a financial sector regulator, if it is a financial creditor of the corporate debtor and is a related party of the corporate debtor solely on account of conversion or substitution of debt into equity shares or instruments convertible into equity shares, prior to the insolvency commencement

date.

Explanation II.— For the purposes of this clause, while a resolution applicant has an account, or an account of a corporate debtor under the management or control of such person or of whom such person is a promoter, classified as non-performing asset and such account was acquired pursuant to a prior resolution plan approved under this Code, then, the provisions of this clause shall not apply to such resolution applicant for a period of three years from the date of approval of such resolution plan by the Adjudicating Authority under this Code;

d) Has been convicted for any offence punishable with imprisonment:

i. for two years or more under any Act specified under the Twelfth Schedule; or

ii. for seven years or more under any law for the time being in force:

Provided that this clause shall not apply to a person after expiry of a period of two years from the date of his release from imprisonment:

Provided further that this clause shall not apply in relation to a connected person referred to in clause (iii) of Explanation I;

e) Is disqualified to act as a director under the Companies Act, 2013;

Provided that this clause shall not apply in relation to a connected person referred to in clause (iii) of Explanation I;

f) Is prohibited by the Securities and Exchange Board of India from trading in securities or accessing the securities markets;

g) Has been a promoter or in the management control of a corporate debtor in which a preferential transaction, undervalued transaction, extortionate credit transaction or fraudulent transaction has taken place and in respect of which an order has been made by the Adjudicating Authority under this Code.

Provided that this clause shall not apply if a preferential transaction, undervalued transaction, extortionate credit transaction or fraudulent transaction has taken place prior to the acquisition of the corporate debtor by the resolution applicant pursuant to a resolution plan approved under this Code or pursuant to a scheme or plan approved by a financial sector regulator or a court, and such resolution applicant has not otherwise contributed to the preferential transaction, undervalued transaction, extortionate credit transaction or fraudulent transaction;

- h) Has executed a guarantee in favor of a creditor in respect of a corporate debtor against which an application for insolvency resolution made by such creditor has been admitted under this Code and such guarantee has been invoked by the creditor and remains unpaid in full or part.*
- i) is subject to any disability, corresponding to clauses (a) to (h), under any law in a jurisdiction outside India; or*
- j) Has a connected person not eligible under clauses (a) to (i)*

Explanation – For the purposes of this clause, the expression “connected person” means:

- i. Any person who is the promoter or in the management or control of the E-auction process applicant; or*
- ii. Any person who shall be the promoter or in management or control of the assets of the Company pursuant to sale thereof as part of the liquidation process of the Company; or*
- iii. The holding company, subsidiary company, associate company or related party of a person referred to in clauses (i) and (ii).*

Provided that nothing in clause (iii) of this Explanation shall apply to a bidder where such bidder is a financial entity and is not a related party of the corporate debtor:

Provided further that the expression “related party” shall not include a financial entity regulated by a financial sector regulator, if it is a financial creditor of the corporate debtor and is a related party of the corporate debtor solely on account of conversion or substitution of debt into equity shares or instruments convertible into equity shares, prior to the insolvency commencement date.

- k) Explanation II—For the purposes of this section, "financial entity" shall mean the following entities which meet such criteria or conditions as the Central Government may, in consultation with the financial sector regulator, notify in this behalf, namely: —*
- (a) a scheduled bank;*
 - (b) any entity regulated by a foreign central bank or a securities market regulator or other financial sector regulator of a jurisdiction outside India which jurisdiction is compliant with the Financial Action Task Force*

Standards and is a signatory to the International Organization of Securities Commissions Multilateral Memorandum of Understanding; any investment vehicle, registered foreign institutional investor, registered foreign portfolio investor or a foreign venture capital investor, where the terms shall have the meaning assigned to them in regulation 2 of the Foreign Exchange Management (Transfer or Issue of Security by a Person Resident Outside India) Regulations, 2017 made under the Foreign Exchange Management Act, 1999 (42 of 1999);

(c) an asset reconstruction company register with the Reserve Bank of India under section 3 of the Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 (54 of 2002);

(d) an Alternate Investment Fund registered with Securities and Exchange Board of India;

(e) Such categories of persons as may be notified by the Central Government.

F. PRE-BID QUALIFICATION FOR BUYER:

A bidder shall not be eligible to submit a bid during the auction process, if the following eligibility criteria, being the pre-bid qualifications are not met (only specifically for Block A and B):

Eligibility Criteria for Companies/LLP/OPC registered with Registrar of Companies under Companies Act:

- a) The Company should be compliant with respect to all the compliances necessary to be followed by the Registered Companies.
- b) None of the connected persons including its directors/designated partners/partners have been convicted for any criminal offence under the Indian Criminal Laws.
- c) None of its directors/designated partners/partners are disqualified to act as a 'director' under the Companies Act, 2013;
- d) Is not prohibited by the Securities and Exchange Board of India from trading in securities or accessing the securities markets;

Prior to bidding, the bidder is required to provide the latest Financial Statements and other necessary documents to the Liquidator.

Eligibility Criteria for Individual: -

- a) Minimum CIBIL should be more than 650 points (A copy of the same should be attached)
- b) Latest ITR: The income tax return should have been filed till the current AY. (Kindly provide a copy of the same)
- c) Is not a defaulter under any Criminal law at the time of filing the bid

Eligibility Criteria for Firms/Sole Proprietorship/HUF /Partnership:

- a) Minimum CIBIL should be more than 650 points (A copy of the same should be attached)
- b) Latest ITR: The income tax return should have been filed till the current AY. (Kindly provide a copy of the same)
- c) Is not a defaulter under any Criminal law at the time of filing the bid

The Liquidator has a discretion to accept bids/offers/interest beyond the above minimum eligibility criteria, in case, the same ensures highest realization to the stakeholders.

G. ELIGIBILITY OF BIDDER WITH REFERENCE TO SECTION 29A:

An E-Auction Process Applicant shall not be eligible to submit a bid for purchase of assets of the Company if it fails to meet the eligibility criteria as set out in Section 29A of the IBC (as amended from time to time).

LEGAL CRITERIA:

An E-Auction Process Applicant shall not be eligible to submit a bid for purchase of assets of the Company if it fails to meet the eligibility criteria as set out in Section 29A of the IBC (as amended from time to time). A careful reading of Section 29-A of the IBC states that a person shall not be eligible to submit a bid, if such person, or any other person acting jointly or in concert with such person –

- a) Is an undischarged insolvent;
- b) Is a willful defaulter in accordance with the guidelines of the Reserve Bank of India issued under the Banking Regulation Act, 1949;

- c) At the time of submission of the resolution plan has an account, or an account of a corporate debtor under the management or control of such person or of whom such person is a promoter, classified as non- performing asset in accordance with the guidelines of the Reserve Bank of India issued under the Banking Regulation Act, 1949 (10 of 1949) 3 [or the guidelines of a financial sector regulator issued under any other law for the time being in force,] and at least a period of one year has lapsed from the date of such classification till the date of commencement of the corporate insolvency resolution process of the corporate debtor:

Provided that the person shall be eligible to submit a bid if such person makes payment of all overdue amounts with interest thereon and charges relating to non-performing asset accounts before submission of bid; Provided further that nothing in this clause shall apply to a bidder where such bidder is a financial entity and is not a related party to the corporate debtor.

Explanation I. - For the purposes of this proviso, the expression "related party" shall not include a financial entity, regulated by a financial sector regulator, if it is a financial creditor of the corporate debtor and is a related party of the corporate debtor solely on account of conversion or substitution of debt into equity shares or instruments convertible into equity shares, prior to the insolvency commencement date.

Explanation II.— For the purposes of this clause, where a resolution applicant has an account, or an account of a corporate debtor under the management or control of such person or of whom such person is a promoter, classified as non-performing asset and such account was acquired pursuant to a prior resolution plan approved under this Code, then, the provisions of this clause shall not apply to such resolution applicant for a period of three years from the date of approval of such resolution plan by the Adjudicating Authority under this Code.

- d) Has been convicted for any offence punishable with imprisonment:
e) for two years or more under any Act specified under the Twelfth Schedule; or
f) for seven years or more under any law for the time being in force

Provided that this clause shall not apply to a person after expiry of a period of two years from the date of his release from imprisonment: Provided further that this clause shall not apply in relation to a connected person referred to in clause (iii) of Explanation I;

- g) Is disqualified to act as a director under the Companies Act, 2013; *Provided that this clause shall not apply in relation to a connected person referred to in clause (iii) of Explanation I;*
- h) Is prohibited by the Securities and Exchange Board of India from trading in securities or accessing the securities markets;
- i) Has been a promoter or in the management control of a corporate debtor in which a preferential transaction, undervalued transaction, extortionate credit transaction or fraudulent transaction has taken place and in respect of which an order has been made by the Adjudicating Authority under this Code;
Provided that this clause shall not apply if a preferential transaction, undervalued transaction, extortionate credit transaction or fraudulent transaction has taken place prior to the acquisition of the corporate debtor by the resolution applicant pursuant to a resolution plan approved under this Code or pursuant to a scheme or plan approved by a financial sector regulator or a court, and such resolution applicant has not otherwise contributed to the preferential transaction, undervalued transaction, extortionate credit transaction or fraudulent transaction.
- j) Has executed a guarantee in favor of a creditor in respect of a corporate debtor against which an application for insolvency resolution made by such creditor has been admitted under this Code and such guarantee has been invoked by the creditor and remains unpaid in full or part.
- k) is subject to any disability, corresponding to clauses (a) to (h), under any law in a jurisdiction outside India; or
- l) Has a connected person not eligible under clauses (a) to (i)

Explanation – For the purposes of this clause, the expression—connected person means:

- i. Any person who is the promoter or in the management or control of the E-auction process applicant; or*
- ii. Any person who shall be the promoter or in management or*

Control of the assets of the Company pursuant to sale thereof as part of the liquidation process of the Company; or

- iii. *The holding company, subsidiary company, associate company or related party of a person referred to in clauses (i) and (ii)*

Provided that nothing in clause (iii) of this Explanation shall apply to a bidder where such bidder is a financial entity and is not a related party of the corporate debtor:

Provided further that the expression —related party¹¹ shall not include a financial entity regulated by a financial sector regulator, if it is a financial creditor of the corporate debtor and is a related party of the corporate debtor solely on account of conversion or substitution of debt into equity shares or instruments convertible into equity shares, prior to the insolvency commencement date.

Explanation II—For the purposes of this section, "financial entity¹¹ shall mean the following entities which meet such criteria or conditions as the Central Government may, in consultation with the financial sector regulator, notify in this behalf, namely: —

- (a) a scheduled bank;*
- (b) any entity regulated by a foreign central bank or a securities market regulator or other financial sector regulator of a jurisdiction outside India which jurisdiction is compliant with the Financial Action Task Force Standards and is a signatory to the International Organisation of Securities Commissions Multilateral Memorandum of Understanding;*
- (c) Any investment vehicle, registered foreign institutional investor, registered foreign portfolio investor or a foreign venture capital investor, where the terms shall have the meaning assigned to them in regulation 2 of the Foreign Exchange Management (Transfer or Issue of Security by a Person Resident Outside India) Regulations, 2017 made under the Foreign Exchange Management Act, 1999 (42 of 1999);*
- (d) an asset reconstruction company register with the Reserve Bank of India under section 3 of the Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 (54 of 2002);*
- (e) an Alternate Investment Fund registered with Securities and Exchange Board*

of India;

(f) Such categories of persons as may be notified by the Central Government.

H. DOCUMENTS REQUIRED TO BE SUBMITTED TO ASCERTAIN ELIGIBILITY OF THE BIDDER

The e-auction would take place as per the IBBI (Liquidation Process) (Second Amendment) Regulations, 2022, which came into force on 16th September, 2022. As per the Amended IBBI (Liquidation Process) Regulation 2022, the following regulations have substituted as follows:

In the principal regulations, in Schedule I, in Para (1), (i) after clause (1), the following shall be inserted, namely: -

- *(1A) The liquidator shall issue a public notice of an auction for sale under regulation 32 within forty-five days from the liquidation commencement date unless the consultation committee advises to extend the timeline.*
- *(1B) The liquidator shall issue public notice for the next auction, in case of failure of the auction, within fifteen days from the last failed auction unless the consultation committee advises to deviate from the specified time period.*
- *(1C) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Schedule, the liquidator shall complete an auction process within thirty-five days from the issue of public notice for auction.*
- *(1D) The liquidator shall provide at least fourteen days from issue of public notice for submission of eligibility documents by prospective bidder.*
- *(1E) The liquidator shall provide to qualified bidder at least seven days, for inspection or due diligence of assets under auction, from the date of declaration of qualified bidder.*
- *(1F) A prospective bidder in an auction process shall deposit earnest money deposit (EMD) at least up to two days before the date of auction.”.*

In light of the above amended regulations, the E-Auction Process Applicant or the Prospective Bidder would need to submit the following forms, documents and authorizations within fourteen days from issue of public notice by the bidder(s) in the following manner:

Submission of Eligibility Documents by Prospective Bidder:

1. KYC Documents.
2. Ownership Structure and Composition of the E-Auction Applicant / Prospective Bidder, Proof of Identity, Current Address Proof, PAN card, valid e-mail ID, Landline and Mobile Phone number.
3. Shareholding Structure of a Company.
4. Related party disclosure.

Documents to be submitted upon approval of the Prospective Bidder by Liquidator i.e., Declaring Qualified Bidders:

After verification of the documents submitted by the Prospective bidders to check the eligibility of the bidder(s) under 29A of the Code, the liquidator would declare the qualified bidder(s). Upon such declaration, the qualified bidders may conduct the due diligence of the assets at the site. The qualified bidders shall deposit the EMD amount and submit following documents to participate in the auction process:

1. Authorization to the Signatory (in case the bidder is a legal entity).
2. Basic details of the bidders attached vide **Annexure I**.
3. Affidavit by the Applicant attached vide **Annexure II**.
4. Confidentiality Undertaking attached vide **Annexure III**.
5. An eligible bidder will need to submit the duly filled, signed and stamped Bid Application Form attached vide **Annexure IV**, and duly filled, signed and stamped Declaration by the Bidders attached vide **Annexure V**.
6. Terms & Condition of the E-auction attached vide **Annexure VI**.
7. Asset Information Sheet attached vide **Annexure VII**.

Please note that only the eligible bidders will gain access to documentation, additional information required for due diligence, after due submission of the required bid form and declaration form. Further, if needed, the site visits for only the eligible bidders may also be coordinated by the Liquidator.

Further, it should be noted that at any stage of the E-Auction process, the liquidator may ask for any documents from the prospective bidders to evaluate their eligibility. The liquidator, at her discretion may disqualify the prospective bidder for non-submission of the requested documents.

I. PHYSICAL VERIFICATION AND SITE VISIT:

The Qualified Bidder is expected to make its own arrangements including accommodation for the Site Visit. All costs and expenses incurred in relation to Site Visits shall be borne by the Qualified Bidder.

In Site Visit, the Qualified Bidder(s) may carry out its own comprehensive due diligence in respect of the Company and shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the condition of the Company, its assets, relevant documents, information etc. whether or not the Qualified Bidder actually inspects or participates in the Site Visit or verifies the document provided by the Liquidator. During the Site Visit, a Qualified Bidder shall not:

Take any photographs of the Site or take any documents back with it; or

- (i) Initiate any discussion regarding the Liquidation Process, with the personnel at Site, during the course of its Site Visit.
- (ii) The Qualified Bidder shall not be entitled to receive any reimbursement of any expenses which may have been incurred in carrying out of due diligence, search of title to the assets and matters incidental thereto or for any purpose in connection with the Bid.
- (iii) Any delay in completion of the Site Visit by the Qualified Bidder, shall not entitle the Qualified Bidder to any extension in the timelines, including the timeline for completion of such Site Visit or submission of the Bid, by or before the last date for submission of the Bid.
- (iv) The Liquidator may coordinate a site visit for Qualified Bidders at any time prior to the closure of the E-Auction process, following a request for such a visit by the Qualified Bidders. The Liquidator will communicate, in advance, to such Qualified Bidder, all the relevant details, terms and conditions, if any, with respect to such Site Visit. The Liquidator reserves the right to not arrange a site visit for any reason whatsoever, irrespective of the request of the Qualified

Bidder.

- (v) The Liquidator may coordinate a site visit for Eligible Bidders at any time prior to the closure of the E-Auction process, following a request for such a visit by the Eligible Bidders. The Liquidator will communicate, in advance, to such Eligible Bidder, all the relevant details, terms and conditions, if any, with respect to such Site Visit.

As per amended IBBI (Liquidation Process) (Second Amendment) Regulations, 2016 (Amended) on 16th September 2022, the liquidator shall be provided to qualified bidder at least seven days, for inspection or due diligence of assets under auction, from the date of declaration of qualified bidder.

The Liquidator reserves the right to not arrange a site visit for any reason whatsoever, irrespective of the request of the Eligible Bidder.

J. DUE DILIGENCE:

The Liquidator shall endeavor to provide necessary assistance, facilitating the due diligence by Qualified Bidders. The information and documents shall be provided by the Liquidator in good faith.

The Liquidator proposes sale of Company's asset on Piecemeal basis in accordance with the provisions of IBC and Liquidation Process Regulations on "**As is where is**", "**As is what is**", "**Whatever there is**" and "**No recourse**" basis and the proposed sale as specified above does not entail transfer of any title, except the title which the Company has on the assets as on date of the transfer. All local taxes /maintenance fee/electricity/water charges/annual lease rentals/unearned income in case of leasehold assets/ insurance premiums/license renewal fees/ license transfer fees and other charges, costs and expenses in connection with the Corporate Debtor or any of its assets as determined by the Liquidator, etc., outstanding as on date or yet to fall due in respect of the relevant asset should be ascertained by the Bidder and would be borne by the Successful Bidder from the date of declaration as Successful Bidder and shall be due and payable immediately as and when intimated by the Liquidator or along with the payment of the balance sale consideration (at the Liquidator's discretion), as per the instructions of the Liquidator but shall in any

event be payable prior to issuance of the sale certificate/sale deed by the Liquidator in favor of the Successful Bidder.

It must also be noted that the Liquidator does not give any assurance or warranty of the physical condition of the assets and their suitability for any sort of operation that the bidder envisages.

K. ASSETS TO BE AUCTIONED AND RESERVE PRICES:

Identification of assets and liabilities for sale and methodology adopted for sale has been decided by the Liquidator in consultation with Stakeholders where it was decided to sell the Corporate Debtor as a piecemeal manner. This document covers the terms and conditions for sale of the Corporate Debtor as a piecemeal manner only and the Reserve Price has been fixed by Liquidator in consultation with the Stakeholders as under: -

It is to be noted that the bidders cannot place a bid for the block of assets at a value below the reserve price. Further, the bidders can increase their Bid by a minimum incremental amount as mentioned in the relevant block of these amounts.

L. E-AUCTION PROCESS:

- a) The Qualified Bidders will deposit earnest money to participate in the auction process.
- Thereafter, the E- Auction will take place as scheduled.
 - Declaration of the Successful Bidder will be done by the Liquidator after due discussion, advice and consent of the stakeholders. The liquidator and stakeholders collectively have all the powers to cancel the entire process of auction, in case the bid amount is not found acceptable to them and to put the assets on re-auction with similar or different terms and conditions. However, the EMD would be refunded to all the bidders without any interest.
 - The Successful bidder will be required to depute their own security guard at the site along with the security guard of the liquidator for securing the assets of the Corporate Debtor.

- b)* It is clarified that any necessary approvals, consents, reliefs that may be required to be obtained by the Successful Bidder with respect to sale of the Company’s assets as a piecemeal Basis as contemplated in this E-Auction Process Information Document have to be obtained by the Successful Bidder without any deviation from the time frame for payment of balance sale consideration as stipulated hereunder. The Liquidator shall not be obligated to relax any obligation of the Successful Bidder due to any failure to obtain such necessary approvals, consents, reliefs that may be required by the Successful Bidder to consummate the transaction within the timelines set out hereunder.
- c)* On receipt of the entire sale consideration (plus applicable taxes and costs as determined by the Liquidator) from the Successful Bidder, the Liquidator shall execute a sale certificate in favor of the Successful Bidder for transferring the Company as a piecemeal basis to the Successful Bidder.
- d)* The Liquidator reserves the right to alter, modify, cancel or relax any of the terms and conditions mentioned in this E-Auction Process Information Document in the interest of the liquidation process of the Company including cancellation of the E-Auction Process at any point of time. Any such alteration, modification, cancellation or relaxation of E-Auction Process shall be binding on the Bidder.
- e)* The Qualified Bidders, participating in the E-Auction Process, will have to Bid for an amount not less than the Reserve Price for acquiring the assets of the Company. A Qualified Bidder may improve its offer, multiple times during the E-auction process.
- f)* The attention of Qualified Bidders is invited to the fact that the Bidders cannot place a Bid for a value below the Reserve Price. Such Bid will stand automatically disqualified.
- g)* The access to the details of the assets of the Company/ Data Room will be provided only to Qualified Bidder, subject to submission of the requisite forms, documents and authorizations; Affidavit and Undertaking; executing a Confidentiality Undertaking.

h) A Qualified Bidder, participating in the E-Auction Process, who has submitted its Bid for the Company, if declared as the Successful Bidder, shall have a right to acquire the Company through a special purpose vehicle (incorporated in India) (“SPV”). The Successful Bidder will be required to intimate the name and requisite details of the SPV (as may be required by the Liquidator), within 15 (fifteen) days from its declaration as the Successful Bidder by the Liquidator in writing. Accordingly, such acquiring SPV shall be bound by all the terms of the E- Auction Process Document (including all payment terms and the Bid Declaration Form submitted by the Qualified Bidder), as if they were the Qualified Bidder. The SPV and all directors and KMPs will be required to be compliant with Section 29A of the Code and submit the ‘Affidavit and Undertaking’ as set out in Annexure II of the E- Auction Process Document, simultaneously with the aforesaid intimation. The SPV shall also submit such necessary documents/undertakings/letters as may be required by the Liquidator within the timelines prescribed by him, at her discretion. Notwithstanding that the Successful Bidder proposes to acquire through SPV, the Successful Bidder shall at all times continue to remain liable for carrying out its obligations (including payment obligations) as per the terms of the E-Auction Process Document.

M. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD):

- a. All the Qualified Bidders shall provide, prior to submission of their E- Auction an amount which is equal to the 10% of the reserve price as earnest money deposit (“EMD”).
- b. It may be noted that the Qualified Bidder may request the Liquidator to permit the Bidder to submit the EMD through its Associate or Associate Company. - iii. The details of any remittances in this regard shall be entered in the online form submitted by the Bidder. The entire EMD amount shall be remitted by the Bidder (s) from one bank account only and to be owned by the Bidder.
- iv. Bidders shall preserve the remittance Challan and shall produce the same in front of the Liquidator as and when demanded.
- v. All the payments to be made by the Bidder under the E-auction shall be intimated to the Liquidator at: compact.lamps@aaainsolvency.com, deepika.bhugra@aaainsolvency.com, assetsale1@aaainsolvency.com.
